Boat Plot Application

Fees are due in January of each year. In the case of non-payment, membership and boat berthing rights will lapse at the end of February.

This application will only be approved after inspection of the boat and trailer (upon initial application and thereafter annually upon renewal) by the compound committee. The boat must be maintained in a seaworthy condition and the trailer kept in a safe and useable condition at all times. **The allocated plot number must be displayed on the boat (on the stern transom) and trailer at all times. Failure to display a plot number may lead to the compound committee painting a number on the hull or removing the boat from the compound.** It is the responsibility of the boat owner to keep the plot clean, tidy and weed free. The Elmore Angling Club cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to boats or equipment left in the compound howsoever caused. The Elmore Angling Club cannot be held responsible for injury to persons using the compound howsoever caused. The committee has the right to re-allocate boats/trailer to a different plot without prior notice. Any subsequent change to boat details (as below) should be notified to the compound committee. Boat plots are NOT transferrable and keys must not be lent to non-members. Motors must not be left in or on boats in the compound at any time. **You are strongly advised to take out at least third party insurance.**

NB.

- Applications will only be considered for boats which are primarily designed for sport angling.
- Boats must be between 12 and 18 feet (3.66m – 5.5m) overall length with a maximum dead hull weight of 750 lb (340kg).
- No boats may be advertised publicly “For Sale” in the compound.
- No motorcars or motorcycle combinations are allowed to enter the compound.
- No motors or fuel may be stored in the compound.
